# Presentation

→ 8 mins speaking time per student + Q&A (7 minutes)

Present:

- a research subject you find interesting (Background + justification of topic choice + recent articles on topic)

Your sources should be in English (bibliography)

You need to use slides that will help you communicate clearly on the subject
